CIECHOCINEK

Famous Polish SPA that boasts of unique graduation towers. We invite to the biggest and the most famous Polish lowland health-one of the most popular holiday-resorts. It is here where you can find particular complex of 19th century saline graduation towers. The air surrounding it, saturated with atomised iodine-content brine, has specific medicinal properties. Beautiful parks and flower-fountains, pump-wells and so on. In the vicinity of town: Raciazek with charming castle ruins and Nieszawa town.

THE PIASTS' ROUTE

Famous archaeological reservation of the Lusatian Culture settlement (650-550 year BC).

The trip shows the traces of Polish statehood origins. The route is one of the best known tourist routes in Poland, where you can find prehistoric and Romanesque monuments of architecture, also old narrow-gauge railway ride from Znin to Venice (where the Narrow-Gauge Railway Museum is located) and Biskupin - famous archaeological reserve of Lusatian culture.



Gniezno - Polish first capital town, magnificent Bernardine cloister in Mogilno, Romanesque collegiate churches of high class in Strzelno, Kruszwica and Inowroclaw towns. In Kruszwica also the famous Mice Tower.



The trip is supposed to last up to 10 hours.

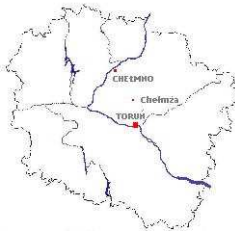

CHELMNO

Medieval town with many superb Gothic historical monuments, beautifully sited on Vistula's high escarpment.

The itinerary (ca. 100 km) to one of the oldest, the most valuable and beautiful towns of Poland with impressive historical monuments of Gothic (numerous large churches, almost completely preserved town defence walls with turrets and gates) and of Renaissance style (the most beautiful town hall of its own in Northern Poland) and unique atmosphere encouraging to make a next visit.

By the way: Chelmza - former seat of Chelmno diocese with fine cathedral.

GOLUB-DOBRZYN & SZAFARNIA

Famous Anna Vasa castle with the Great International Knights' Tournaments.

Golub-Dobrzyn - the town on the Drweca River, combined of two former urban units: Golub - situated on the northern bank and Dobrzyn on the southern one. One of the best known castles in Poland is located in Golub. Erected in the 14th century by the Teutonic Knights and after being returned to Poland in 1466 (the 2nd Torun Treaty) the seat of Anna Vasa

Royal Princess. It's picturesquely situated on a hill, known, among others, because of The Great International Knights' Tournaments in July.

The nearby Szafarnia is the second Frederic Chopin centre in Poland, right after his birthplace - Zelazowa Wola.

TEUTONIC CASTLES OF CHELMNO LAND

The Chelmno Land (Ziemia Chelminska) - the oldest Teutonic territory in Poland from where the pagan Prussians conquest and the powerful Teutonic State creating started. There are the oldest Teutonic Knights' castles in Chelmno Land. The very first and original one in Torun, the other most important in Golub, Radzyn Chelminski (ruins of the most powerful stronghold just after Malbork), Kwidzyn, Bierzgowo Castle (Zamek Bierzgowski), Rogozno, etc.



The trip is supposed to last up to 10 hours.
